SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The Kentucky Trucking Education Foundation (KTEF) in association with sponsorship would like to announce their endeavor to offer a scholarship award to an eligible student attending a Kentucky College or University, pursuing a course of study related to the Transportation industry, or a Technical College to obtain their CDL, Diesel Tech Certification, or other appropriate certification.

The total amount of the scholarship will be \$2,000. Scholarship monies are to be used for tuition purposes only.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A high school senior or any college freshman, sophomore, junior or senior in good standing, attending an accredited community college, four-year college, or university in the State of Kentucky.
- 2. Planning to earn a degree or certification in a field of study involved in the Trucking Industry.
- 3. The applicant must also meet at least one (1) of the requirements listed below:
- ❖ A family member that is a member of the KTA.
- *A family member currently involved in the Transportation industry.

The scholarship recipient must show excellent scholastic achievement and plan to be enrolled in 12 or more credit hours each semester (N/A for CDL/Diesel Tech/ Other technical certification). The applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

The criteria for awarding the scholarship will be based on a combination of financial need, academic aptitude, and moral character. The scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, color, national origin, religion, sex, age, or disability. The scholarship will be void because of expulsion or dismissal from school, failure to maintain full-time status (taking 12 or more credit hours and maintaining a 2.5 GPA minimum per semester), discontinuance of the education process for more than 12 consecutive months,or failure to comply with any deadlines outlined within this application. The KTEF also reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship at their discretion. Application Packets are due by April 15th, 2023

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET INFORMATION

A potential candidate for a scholarship must provide all the following information: "Not Applicable" (N/A) or "None", is acceptable as an answer. Incomplete Scholarship Application Packets will not be considered.

- 1. Send a completed Scholarship Application Form(attached)
- 2. Send a complete official high school transcript (if upcoming college freshman) or a complete official college transcript. (Anything without an official sealfrom the registrar will not be accepted)
- 3. Completion of a 500-word essay (as outlined in the Scholarship Application Form)
- 4. Provide the name, address, and telephone number of the person and department within the college, university, or technical school to which the scholarship check should be sent for disbursement. If you have not decided on a school at the time of application, please indicate the schools that have accepted your application.
- 5. The winning applicant will be requested to provide a photo for use at the awards ceremony, publication in the Kentucky Trucker magazine, KTA web-site, and email announcement to membership. DO NOT SEND PHOTO AT THIS TIME.
